



# Susquehanna Riverlands 2019 Mini Grants Program CALL FOR LETTERS OF INTENT

The Lancaster Conservancy is pleased to announce the 2019 round of the Susquehanna Riverlands Mini Grant Program. This program provides local non-profit, municipal and educational stakeholders with competitive funding opportunities for place-based strategies that address sustainability, conservation, preservation, restoration and recreational use of natural lands and resources in the Lower Susquehanna Valley of York and Lancaster Counties.

## About The Susquehanna Riverlands

The Susquehanna Riverlands is one of seven Conservation Landscapes supported by the Pennsylvania Department of Conservation and Natural Resources (DCNR) and is a partnership between the Lancaster Conservancy, which serves as the program's external lead, DCNR and a constellation of community partners working together to enhance public access to the Susquehanna River, preserve environmentally sensitive areas and the forested river landscape, improve water quality, provide additional recreational and educational opportunities and revitalize Rivertown communities.

## Funding Details

The Lancaster Conservancy, as the external lead of the Susquehanna Riverlands, administers the Mini Grant Program with funding provided via DCNR. Single-year grant requests for a minimum of **\$2,500** to a maximum of **\$25,000** are considered for projects that work towards advancing the goals of the Susquehanna Riverlands and should help build and sustain the landscape's sense of place. ## Eligibility and Rules

- Non-profit organizations that have a 501(c)3 status and are registered with the PA Bureau of Charitable Organizations, municipalities, counties, and educational institutions can apply for a mini grant.
- Applicants must match these funds at a 1:1 ratio with additional funding and/or eligible in-kind services. 50% of the match must be in cash.
- Projects must occur in the Susquehanna Riverlands Conservation Landscape region, click here form more details.
