RULES AND REGULATIONS

- Closed from dusk to dawn
- Use of preserve is at visitor's own risk
- Stay on marked trails
- Respect our neighbors
- No camping or overnight parking
- No motorized vehicles
- Pets must be on leash
- No open fires (including fireworks, smoking and grilling)
- No alcohol or illegal substances
- No drones, game cameras, or amplified sounds
- No taking of mineral, fossil, or archeological specimens
- No disturbance, removal, or injury of native plants
- Hunting is only permitted on authorized preserves. PA Game Commission Rules and Regulations apply and are strictly enforced.
- Events that include 15 people or more require Conservancy approval. See our website for details.

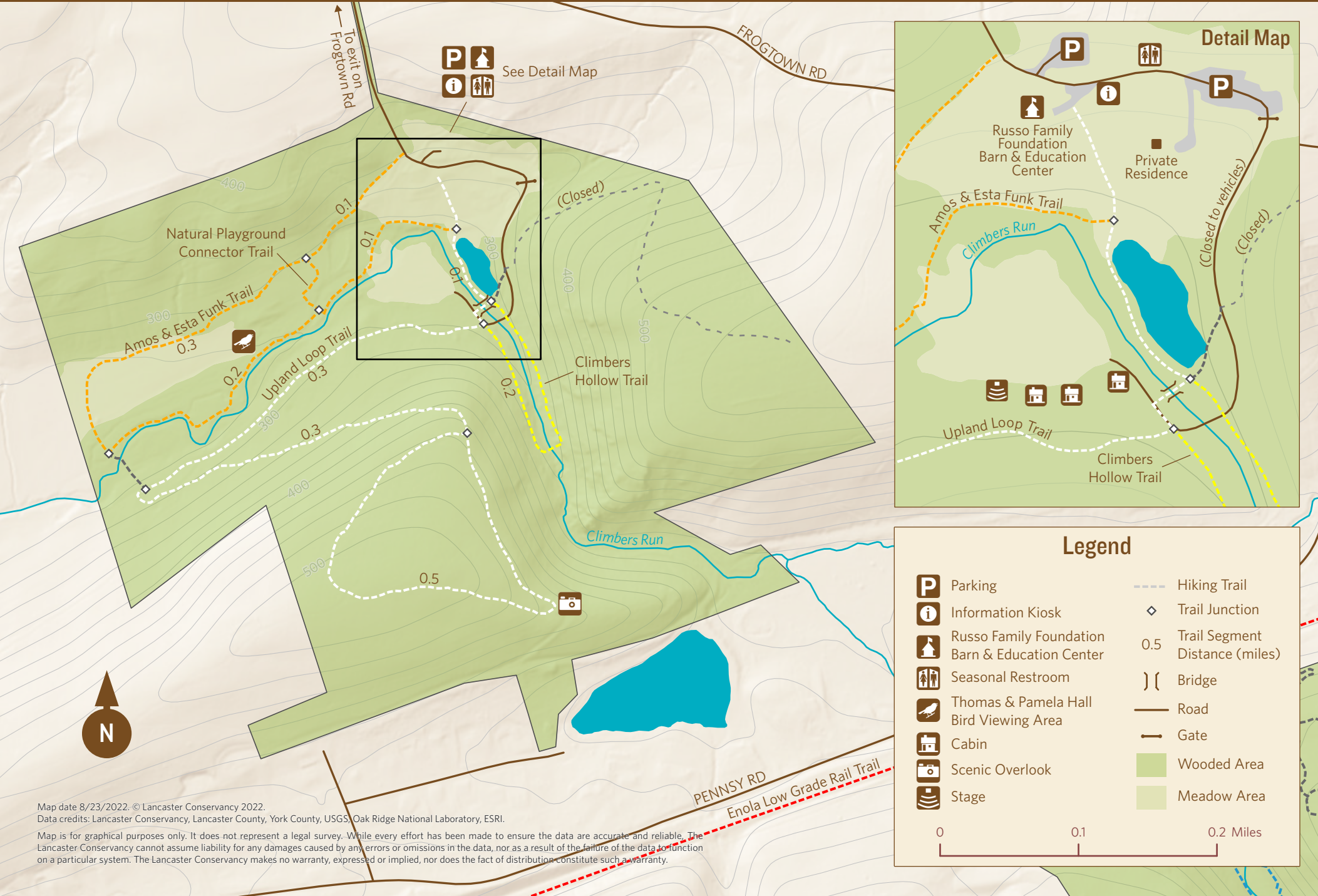
