



#### PROTECT

Lancaster Conservancy is an accredited nonprofit land trust that protects and restores natural lands for future generations. Since our founding in 1969 by local anglers, hunters, and naturalists, the Conservancy has saved over 10,000 acres of forested and wild lands to protect the ecosystems and landscapes upon which we depend for food, clean water, clean air, economic and public health, and the restoration of the mind and spirit.

#### **2** EXPLORE

We manage the lands we own in 50 nature preserves located in Lancaster County as well as along the Susquehanna River in York County. Preserves like Welsh Mountain, Shenks Ferry, and Otter Creek provide the community with opportunities for hiking, fishing, hunting, and creek stomping.





#### **3** RESTORE

The Conservancy stewards the ecosystems our preserves protect, regenerating native wildlife habitats by planting trees, restoring streams and wetlands, and removing invasive species.

#### **4** EDUCATE

Our work cultivates a connection with nature and, through educational and volunteer programs, teaches the community about the importance of conservation, clean water, native species, biodiversity, and responsible land use.
