Points	Criteria	Description
10	Ready to Go	Overall project scope and planning (including match, property access, work plan, budget) are clear and concise
20	SRCL Mission Alignment	5 points per priority scope of work element addressed: <b>(1)</b> habitat and trail (re)connectivity, <b>(2)</b> sustainable public access to the Susquehanna River and its surrounding natural lands, <b>(3)</b> emphasize community partnership and collaboration, and <b>(4)</b> ecosystem health
20	Need	Project need (including equity) is clearly described; scope of work is realistic and aligns with project goals.
20	Results	Applicant describes expected impact on the community and includes reasonable, measurable community results. Measurements of success should have quantifiable outcomes that can be reviewed to determine success in the short and long term.
10	Partnership & Collaboration	Collaboration with partners on projects is strongly encouraged. Higher points will be given to those with more partners involved and when the partners or contributors are in or serve the Susquehanna Riverlands region. <i>Letters of commitment with statements of cash or in-kind match are required. Letters of support from other partners are encouraged.</i>
20	Budget & Match	Budget is thorough and complete, and match is secured. Projects will have the highest ranking when matched funding is immediately available. Projects with undetermined or unlikely funding will rank lower. For guidelines on the eligibility of matching funds, refer to the Department of Conservation and Natural Resources' Community Conservation Partnership Program (C2P2) program guidelines.
