# Invest in Our Local Outdoor Economy and a Better Quality of Life

- ▶ **Access to bike or walking paths is consistently a top three consideration for home buyers across demographics and political persuasion.**
- ▶ **50% of recent college graduates say “place” is more important than job in their career search.**

## ▶ PROTECT

Since our founding in 1969, Lancaster Conservancy has protected over 11,000 acres of natural lands in Lancaster County and in York County along the Susquehanna River. Our 50+ nature preserves provide habitat for plants and animals as well as places for our community to hike, hunt, fish, and connect with nature.

## ▶ RESTORE


We care for the lands we protect, restoring them to healthy, resilient, biodiverse natural spaces while also creating infrastructure to allow sustainable visitation.






