Now celebrating its 10th anniversary, Lancaster Water Week seeks to educate and empower our community to care for the 1,400 miles of streams and rivers in Lancaster County. These cricks and creeks are the source of our drinking water, drive economic and agricultural growth, and allow us to escape into nature to fish, paddle, and swim. Many of these beautiful streams are polluted, but there is an incredible effort underway to bring them back to health in our lifetime. Over the past nine years, Lancaster Conservancy and our incredible partners have hosted over 300 events inviting our community to explore outdoors, create habitat, and protect our waterways.

The 10th anniversary of Water Week provides an opportunity to reflect more deeply on the importance of clean streams and rivers in Lancaster County.
